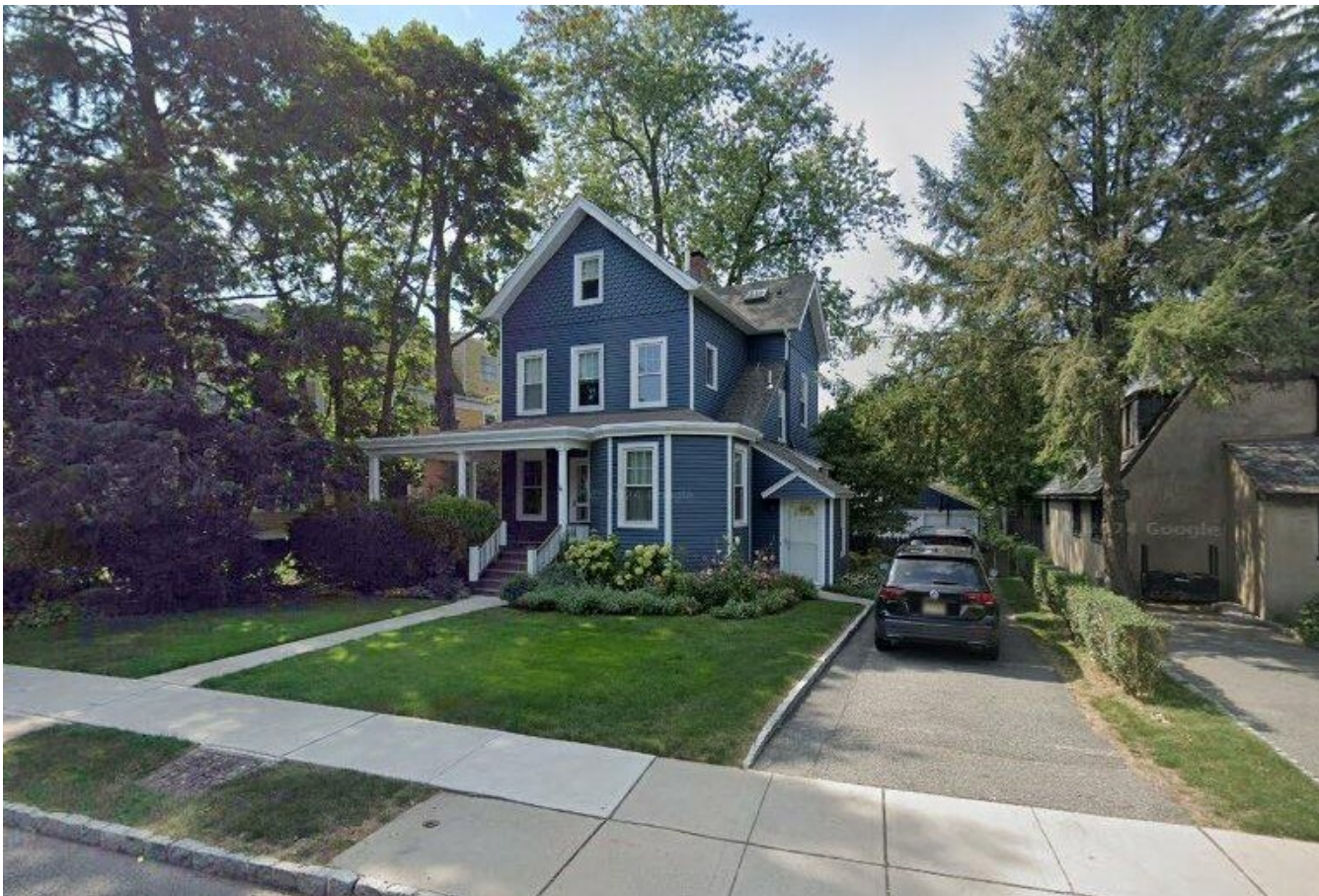

## Obituary

### Francis H. Pierce.

Francis H. Pierce, seventy-nine, who had lived in Montclair for more than fifty years and was a lifelong resident of this section, died at his home, 46 Northview avenue, Saturday morning from apoplexy. Death followed a short illness.

Mr. Pierce was born in West Caldwell. For more than fifty years he had been in business as a contractor here. He was a member of the Union Congregational church and of the Montclair Lodge, Royal Arcanum.

He leaves a wife, Mrs. Sarah Vanhoof Pierce; four daughters, Mrs. Charlotte Pierce Clute, Mrs. Herbert Force and Miss Jane M. Pierce, all of Montclair, and Mrs. W. H. Hoagland

Verona, and two brothers, Albert Pierce of Verona and Sylvanus Pierce of West Caldwell.

Funeral services were held at the home at 2:30 o'clock Monday afternoon. The Rev. Georg C. Vincent, pastor of the Union Congregational church, officiated. Interment was in Clinton cemetery, Caldwell Township.

## Funeral of F. H. Pierce

Funeral services for Francis Henry Pierce of 46 Northview avenue, Montclair, will be conducted this afternoon at the home by Rev. Dr. George C. Vincent, pastor of the Union Congregational Church, that town. Interment will be in Clinton Cemetery.

Mr. Pierce died Saturday from a stroke of apoplexy after an illness of three weeks. He was born in West Caldwell seventy-eight years ago and had been a resident of Montclair more than fifty years. In business he was a contractor. He was a member of the Union Congregational Church and also held membership in Montclair Chapter, Royal Arcanum.

Besides his wife Mr. Pierce leaves four daughters, Mrs. Charlotte Pierce Clute, Mrs. Herbert Force and Miss Jane M. Pierce, all of Montclair, and Mrs. W. H. Hoagland of Verona.

Clinton Cemetery is **Hillside Cemetery**. Clinton was the name for the Horseneck Road section of Caldwell Township (Fairfield).
