THEIR GOLDEN WEDDING.

Mr. and Mrs. Elijah Pearce Receive Congratulations on Completion of Fifty Years of Happy Married Life.

Wedded in Montclair half a century ago, and making their home here for forty-five years, is the experience of Mr. and Mrs. Elijah Pearce of No. 22 Elston road, who celebrated their golden anniversary on Tuesday evening. Mr. Pearce has attained his eighty-third year and Mrs. Pearce her seventy-fifth.

The old Sigler homestead, now the Hamilton farm, where the bride was born and grew up as a girl, was the scene of the wedding, February 18, 1869. A happy feature at the gathering of friends and relatives at the anniversary celebration was the presence of the maid of honor, Miss Harriet Force, who attended the bride at the nuptials, and Mr. Charles Demarest, of Newark, who was a guest at the wedding. The cake for the anniversary was designed and baked by Isaac Sigler,

brother of the bride, who is one of Montclair's veteran merchants.

Mr. Pearce for many years has been an employing contractor and mason and has built a number of good buildings in Montclair. He is a charter member of the Montclair Fire Department and was actively engaged in Hook and Ladder Company No. 1, and served a much longer term than required to entitle him to membership in the Exempt Firemen's Association.

Mrs. Phebe Pearce 95, Died Sunday

Services Will Be Conducted at 3 P. M. Today.

Services for Mrs. Phebe S. Pearce, wife of the late Elijah Pearce, one of Montclair's first mason contractors and one time volunteer assistant chief of the Fire Department, will be conducted at 3 o'clock this afternoon at the home of her son, Raymond S. Pearce of 22 Elston Road.

Mrs. Pearce was 95. She died at the home of her son Sunday after a brief illness. At the time of her death Mrs. Pearce was the oldest living native resident of Montclair. Her father, the late Aaron Sigler, had also been a native of Montclair. Her mother, the late Caroline Vreeland Sigler, had been born in Nutley.

Until a year ago Mrs. Pearce had remained active in religious and political affairs. She had been a member of Upper Montclair Presbyterian Church and one of the original members of the Old Dutch Reformed Church in Bloomfield.

1843 - 1939 age 95

At the age of 89 in 1932 when Mrs. Pearce cast her vote for Herbert Hoover she received a congratulatory telegram from Mrs. Hoover. She had always shown a lively interest in town affairs. At home she had made a hobby of caring for her flower garden.

Her family for several generations back had owned a great deal of property in Upper Montclair. Her husband, who died in 1925, and her father were instrumental in developing much of it. Elston Road, where her son now lives, was developed by her husband.

A nephew, Howard Sigler, is now the Montclair tax collector. Besides her son and nephew, she leaves another son, Elston E. Pearce of Englewood; a brother, Melvin Sigler of Cedar Grove; three grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

The Rev. Robert C. Williamson of Upper Montclair Presbyterian Church, assisted by the Rev. Howard A. Adair of East Paterson Presbyterian Church, will officiate at the services. Burial will be in Mt. Hebron Cemetery.

Elijah Pearce, eighty-nine years old, of No. 22 Elston road, died yesterday at his home following a short illness. Funeral services will be conducted Monday afternoon at his late residence by Rev. Robert C. Williamson, pastor of the Presbyterian church of Upper Montclair, and Rev. H. A. Adair, of Patterson. Interment will be in Mt. Hebron cemetery.

Mr. Pearce was one of Montclair's oldest citizens. He was a charter member of the Montclair volunteer fire department and Exempt Fireman's Association. He was also a charter member of the Montclair lodge of Masons. Mr. Pearce was the oldest member of the Presbyterian church of Upper Montclair.

Besides his wife, Mrs. Phoebe S. Pearce, Mr. Pearce is survived by two sons, Elston E. and Raymond S. Pearce.
