His second marriage was with **Hattie Utter** on 1/13/1874 at Mauston Wisconsin.

An obit in a Mauston Wisconsin newspaper says that **William Davis Pierce** died in his Hillyard, Washington home on Saturday 2/2/1924 after an illness of only a few hours. He was 77. He was a building contractor and carpenter in Mauston Wisconsin for many years before moving to Hillyard, Washington in 1910.
