Services for Mrs. Myra Huyler Ames, wife of Theodore Ames, who died Saturday at Mountainside Hospital after an illness of twelve weeks, were held at 3 P. M. yesterday at her home, 124 Inwood Avenue. The Rev. James T. Lodge, Rector of St. John's Episcopal Church, officiated. Burial was in Rosedale Cemetery.

Born in Hackensack sixty-eight years ago, Mrs. Ames had lived in Montclair thirty-nine years. She was a member of St. John's Church and its needlework guild and was its group leader. Mr. Ames is a special partner in the New York brokerage firm of Boody, McLellan & Co.
