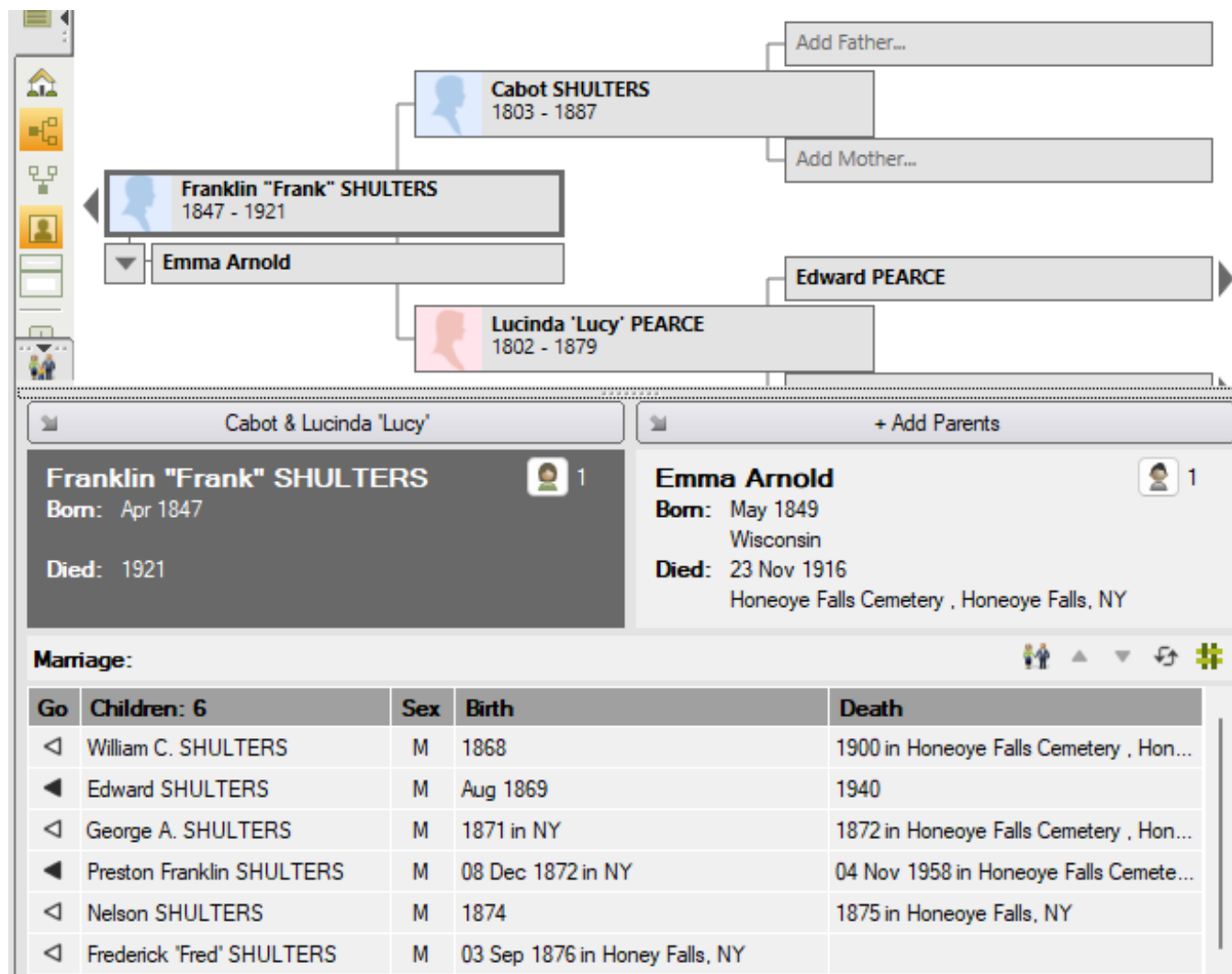

Honeoye Falls station depot where Pearce relatives may have stopped for a visit to Mrs. Lucy Pearce Shulters.

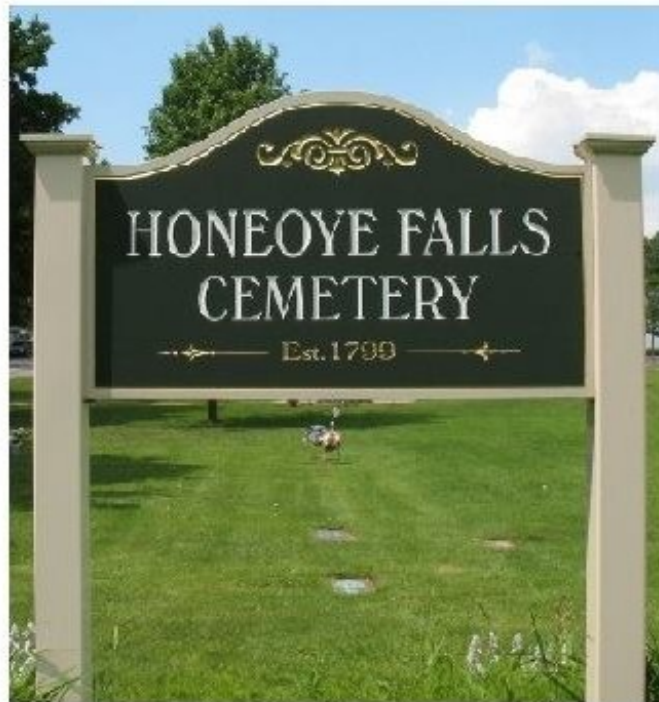
It was 303 miles from Fairfield NJ to Honeoye Falls, NY.

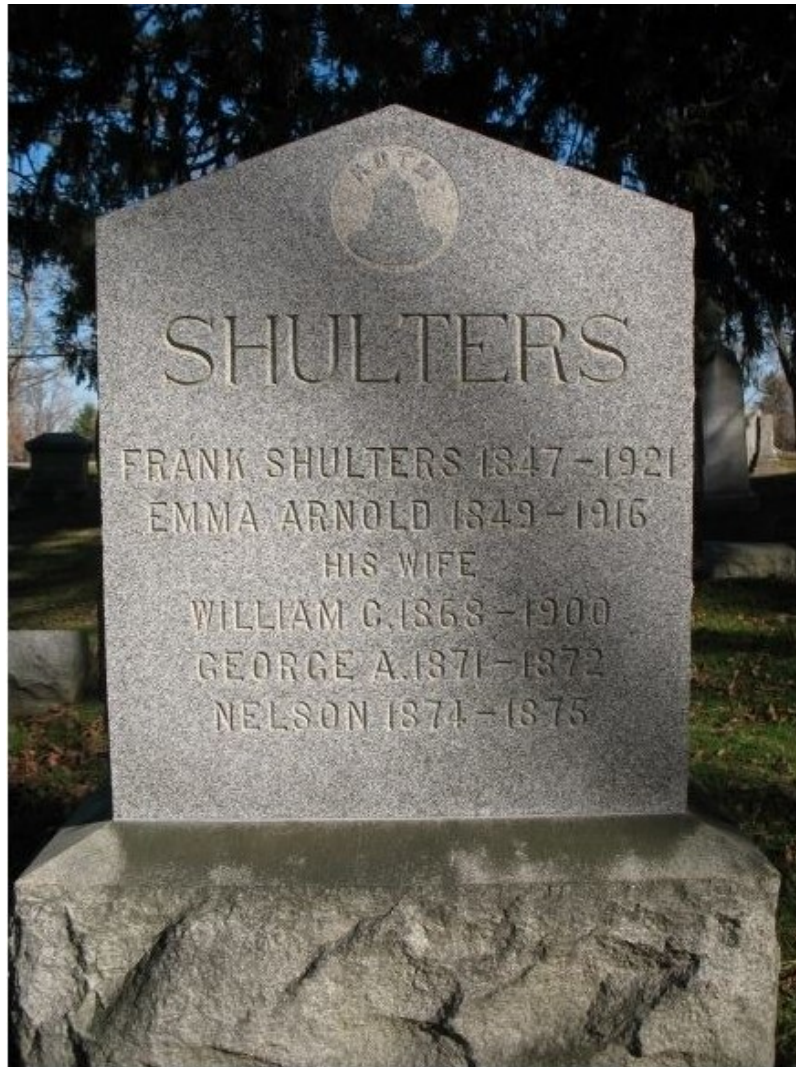

**2/10/1881—1932 (50)** Evergreen Cemetery, Bristol, NY.  
Son of Julius SHULTERS and Louise Marie Woolston.

1910 graduate of University of Illinois, Champaign, Illinois. 1918 professor at the same college. Used sister's Canandaigua NY address for the draft.

A 1922 passport shows him as an Indiana professor about to travel overseas.

Mary Kate Shulters age 44 and John Raymond Shulters age 50 were siblings. Their mother was **Lucy Pearce Shulters**, who had 12 children.
