Monroe King served a second time in the Union Army. He was drafted to Company A, **NJ 33rd Infantry** Regiment on **2/22/1865**. 20th Corps.

Mustered out on 5/4/1865.

“The **33rd New Jersey Infantry**, also known as the "Mutinous 33rd," played a significant role in the Civil War, particularly during the Chattanooga Campaign and the Atlanta Campaign. Organized in 1863, the regiment saw action in several key battles and campaigns.”

Monroe was mustered out 5/4/1865. Injury ??
