



Phebe age 15 was the daughter of Edward Pearce and Hannah Stagg of Fairfield NJ.

Eli age 19 was the son of Daniel TOMPKINS and Phoebe WALKER of Livingston NJ.



2nd generation Edward Pearce 1773-1834 of Fairfield, Essex County, NJ was age 54 when his 8th child of his 12 kids, Phebe Pearce, married Eli Tomkins 2/14/1828 <u>Valentine's Day</u>. Her mother was Hannah Stagg 1778-1846. Edward and Hannah are buried at Hillside Cemetery. They are the branch #3 for the 2013 Pierce's.

Phebe's brother Joseph Pierce is our branch #3 generation 3.

Widowed by 1900. A Shoemaker in 1902.
