

Caleb DODD age 21 married Catherine Ann LEONARD on 6/6/1853 in Waterville, Ohio. They had a child Caleb Elijah DODD born 4/26/1857.



These Dodd's lived in Waterville, Ohio, a Toledo suburb.

Notice the 2 mules on left, pulling the boat. A few ducks pass by.



Canal boats stopped to shop at the Ostrander store in 1868.

"The **Ohio 14th Infantry regiment**, a key unit in the Civil War, was Northwest Ohio's first regiment raised for the war, and Ohio's first to see action, fighting in the Western Theater and participating in battles like Philippi, Lexington, Chickamauga, and those around Atlanta. " (Wikipedia 2025)

The Ohio 14th Infantry Regiment was organized at Toledo, Ohio, on April 25, 1861, under Union Colonel (later Brig General) **James Steedman.**

Steedman is in the Pearce-Pierce book from his marriage to Sarah 'Miranda' STILES of Caldwell NJ. Miranda's sister Malvina Stiles had married Elijah Dodd, father of Caleb Dodd who is this chapter. That makes Caleb a nephew to Steedman.

The regiment moved to Cleveland, Ohio, 4/25/1861, then to Columbus, Ohio, 5/22/1861. 1875 Waterville, Ohio map that shows property owned by **Elijah Dodd**, brother to Ezra Squires Dodd (wife was Sarah Ann Pearce)

Elijah Dodd was born 6/6/1806 in Fairfield NJ and died 10/24/1876 (70) at Waterville, Ohio. The parents were Caleb DODD and Mary "Polly" BATES. Caleb died when Elijah was age 4. Elijah honored his father Caleb by naming his first child Caleb in 1831.

Years later, the grandson Caleb became a Captain in the Union Army during the Civil War.
