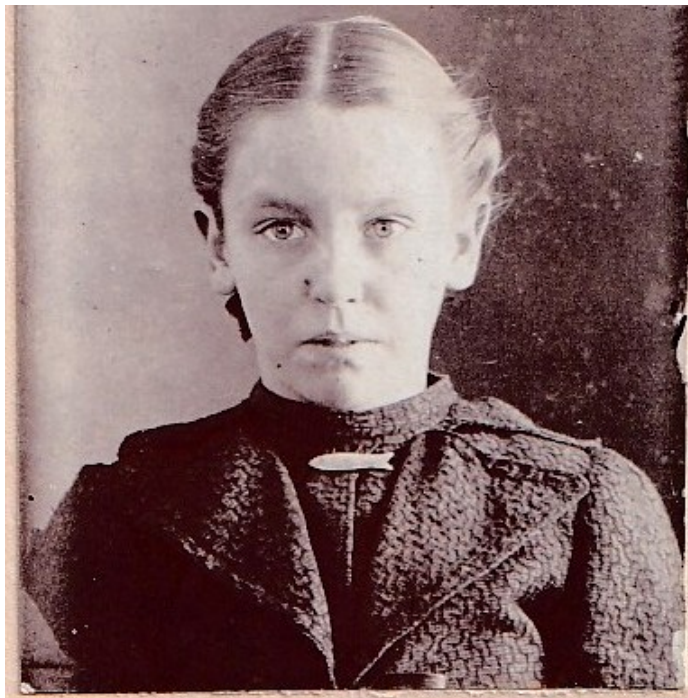

S. RECTOR DIES IN MASON CITY

Rites Will Be Friday;
Burial Near Sheffield

NORA SPRINGS—Seymer H. Rector, 60, died at 11:20 a. m. Tuesday, in a Mason City hospital, where he underwent an operation

three weeks ago.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Sheckler funeral home. Burial will be at West Fork cemetery, several miles east of Sheffield.

Seymer Henry Rector was born March 15, 1883, in South Dakota. He was a son of Sherman and Anna Rector. Most of his life was spent in the vicinity of Hampton and Aredale. He moved to Nora Springs from Aredale five years ago, March 1, 1938. He worked on the section crew of the Rock Island railroad for the last two

summers. Since March 18 he had been employed by the Decker packing company in Mason City.

He was married to Mrs. Jessie McMillan of Mauston, Wis., at Mauston on Dec. 4, 1919.^N One son, William Edward, was born to them. He was fatally injured in 1931 at the age of 10, suffering a skull fracture when he was thrown from a manure spreader.

Survivors are the widow; a step-daughter, whom he had reared since she was 4 years old, Mrs. Kenneth Walton of Arcata,

Cal., and her two children, Floyd and Betty; two brothers, Ed Rector of Modesto, Cal., and Alonzo Rector of South Dakota; and a sister, Mrs. Mattie Jones of Miltonvale, Kans.*

Jessie died in 1950. Her 3rd husband Ed, brother to deceased Seymer, had Jessie buried with his brother Seymer.
