

It served as a hospital during the Revolution when a smallpox epidemic broke out among the soldiers quartered in and around Morristown. (Wikipedia)


Andrew and Amy are supposedly buried in **Lot #6** per will at Trenton, NJ; however, the cemetery says it is a different lot #. No tombstone.
