She enjoyed playing softball in high school. Pam was a teacher in the Chicago school system.

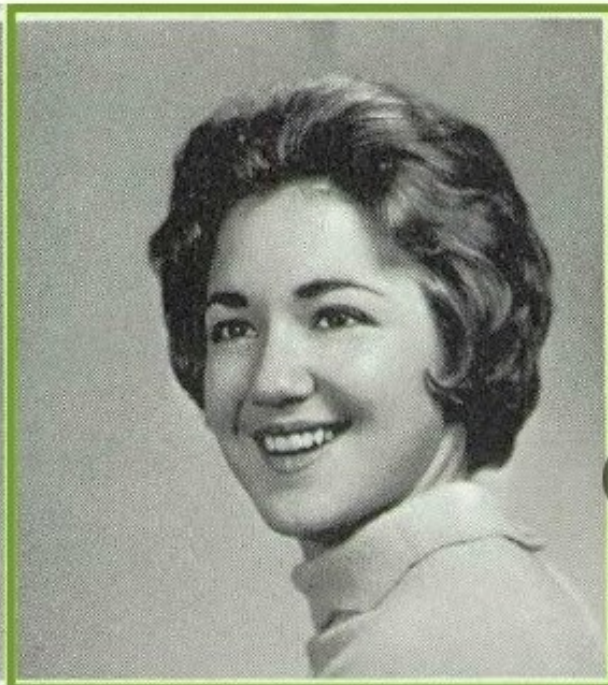
She had an older brother **Steven Wallace Pierce** who was born in 1942.
