

Albert Zabriskie Duryea whose name begins this record, was born March 26, 1837, on the farm where he now carries on agricultural pursuits. In the district schools near his home he acquired his education and then antered upon his business career by learning the carpenter's trade in Newark and in New York city. He followed that pursuit for some years, but is now

devoting his energies to the farm, which he has placed under a good state of cultivation. The fields are well tilled, everything in good repair, and the neat and thrifty appearance of the place indicates the careful supervision the owner.

Mr. Duryea's home is presided over by one of the estimable ladies of the township, who in her maidenhood was Miss Mary Matilda Pierce daughter of Henry G. and Emeline (Hicks) Pierce, of Newark. Their marriage was celebrated May 2, 1860, and four children graced their union, namely

Anna Maria, born November 11, 1863, now the wife of Charles L. Van Duyne, of Union Hill, Hudson county, New Jersey, by whom she has three children—Ernest, Mary Matilda and Grace; William A., who was born July 29, 1865, and married Elizabeth Seaman, by whom he has two cinderen—Elsie May and Richard Halsey; Edward E., born May 25, 1870, now at home; and Raymond P., who was born December 18, 1875, and make his home in Newark.

In his political associations Mr. Duryea is a Democrat, and for thirten years served as county committeemen, proving a most capable and trus worthy officer. He has also been school trustee for many years and be greatly advanced the cause of education by his earnest, untiring efforts. The family attend the Dutch Reformed church and are well known in this community.

Sorted by death date: Some children will have their own chapter.

<u>1848</u>: 2nd child. Tragedy visited Henry and Emily PEARCE when their daughter **Emeline PEARCE** died 8/26/1848 age 7 from dysentery. She was named after her mom. The daughter was born 11/12/1840.

1872: 3rd child. Cynthia Daughty PEARCE was born 6/15/1843 in Newark NJ. She married 4/29/1867 to Theodore Newton Logan. Cynthia died 4/23/1872 age 28 from child birth. Evergreen Cem, Hillside, NJ.

Theodore named the baby **Cynthia Mae Logan** using the mom's first name. In 1902, she would marry Charles Norman and reside in Cedar Grove, NJ. Cynthia died 3/30/1957 age 84. Both are at Evergreen Cem.

Theodore would eventually marry a second time; Cassandra Adelaide Van Ness of the Jacksonville NJ area. They would have a girl Harriet Johnston 'Hattie' Logan born Christmas day 12/25/1879. Hattie would live to 1948 age 68. She married Harry Livingstone PARKHURST on 10/5/1908. Restland Memorial Park, East Hanover, NJ

1872: 9th child. 22 days after Cynthia died, Stephen Albert 'Albert' PEARCE born 9/13/1856 and died 5/15/1872 age 15. Evergreen Cem. Hillside, NJ.

<u>1880</u>: 11th child. **Horace Olds PEARCE** born 7/28/1864 in Newark NJ during the Civil War. Died 1/5/1880 age 15 in the CMC explosion. Clinton Cem, Irvington NJ.

1900: Parent. Henry George PEARCE born 12/29/1812 and died 9/6/1900 age 87. Clinton Cem, Irvington NJ

1903: 4th child. George Henry PEARCE born 3/16/1845, died 2/22/1903 age 57. Married 7/15/1875 in Baltimore Maryland to Mary Ann 'Annie' KLOPPMEIER. Civil War vet. Fairmount Cem, Newark, NJ

They had 6 PEARCE children: Mabel, George, Arthur, Frederick, Oscar and Gertrude PEARCE

1904: 5th child. Edward Hatch PEARCE born 4/11/1847 in Caldwell NJ and died 6/1/1904 age 57. Married 1876 in Pine Brook, NJ to Laura STAGER of Montville NJ. Montville Dutch Reformed Church Cem, Montville, NJ.

They had 9 PEARCE children. Frederick Ellsworth, Wallace, Florence, Benjamin, Stanley, Daisey, Leroy K. "Roy", Mary and Ella PEARCE.

1914: 1st child. Mary Matilda PEARCE born 12/29/1838 and died 12/5/1914 age 75. Married 5/2/1860 in Montville NJ to Albert Zabriske DURYEA. Montville Dutch Reformed Church Cem, Montville, NJ.

They had 5 DURYEA children: Richard, Anna, William, Edward and Raymond Duryea.

1923: 8th child. Benjamin Franklin 'Frank' PEARCE born 7/12/1853 and died 2/21/1923 age 69. Married to Elizabeth STEN-GEL. 1878—carpenter; lived at 85 Pacific Street, Newark, NJ. Clinton Cem, Irvington NJ

Children: unknown.

1923: 10th child. Wallace Irving PEARCE born 10/14/1858 and died 10/7/1923 age 64. Married to Sarah J. 'Sadie' BEECROFT on 9/21/1881. Clinton Cem, Irvington NJ.

They had 3 PEARCE children: Alma, Leroy and Ethyl PEARCE.

<u>1934</u>: 7th child. Charles Hicks PEARCE born 9/24/1851 and died 7/22/1934 age 82. Married 10/10/1892 in Montville NJ to **Anna May 'Annie' MYERS.** Montville Dutch Reformed Church Cem, Montville, NJ.

They had 3 PEARCE children: Elsie, Ida and Bertha PEARCE.

Glen had the pleasure in 1983 interviewing **Mrs Elsie Ruth Pearce Riker** (1893-1991 age 98) at her Paterson NJ home. Twice. Very nice lady. Her niece, Bernice Mulligan (1933-2011 age 78) helped.

1943: 6th child. Emma Luezer PEARCE born 5/1/1849 in Newark NJ and died in 1943 age 93. Married to Henry Mead VAN NESS on 11/22/1870. Clinton Cem, Irvington NJ.

They had 8 VAN NESS children: Rosanna, William, Eva, Ida, Daisey, Laura, Lloyd and Edith Van Ness.

Mary Matilda 'Matilda' PEARCE was the first child of Henry age 26 and Emily age 19. Mary was born 12/29/1838 in Newark NJ, just 4 days after Christmas. It must have been a hectic but wonderful 1838 Christmas. She used the name Matilda Duryea in the 1870 Federal Census.

Matilda married **Albert Zabriske Duryea** on 5/2/1860 at the Montville Episcopal Church, Montville, NJ.


Mary died 12/5/1914. The couple are buried at the Montville Ref Church Cem, Church Lane, Montville, NJ
