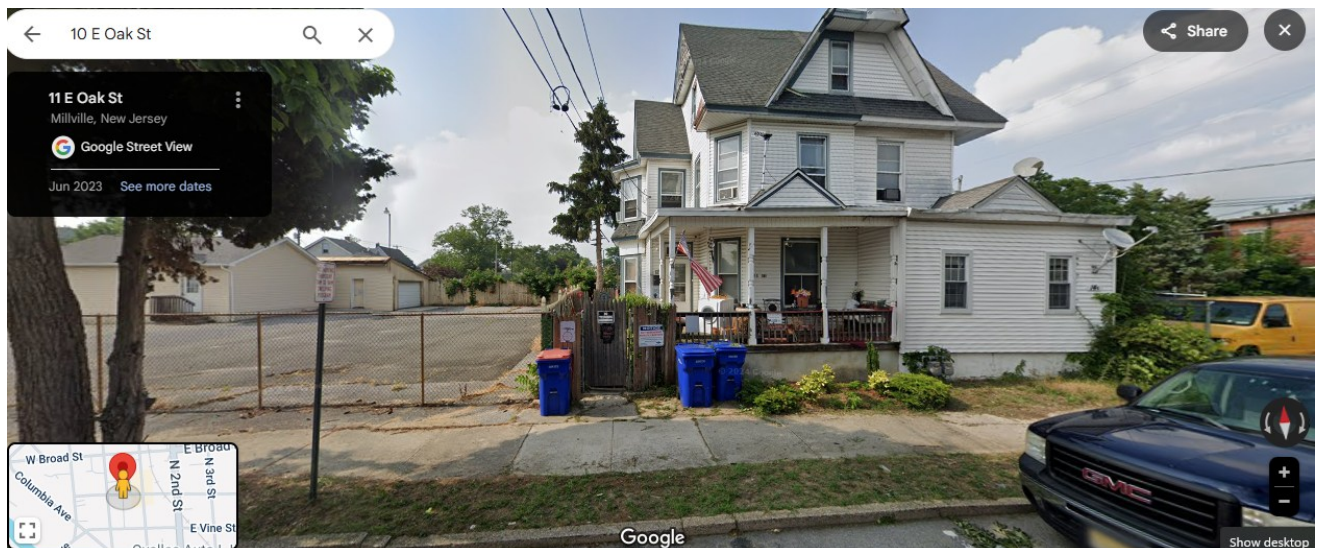


WW2 **1941** draft registration card. Bert was age 52.
