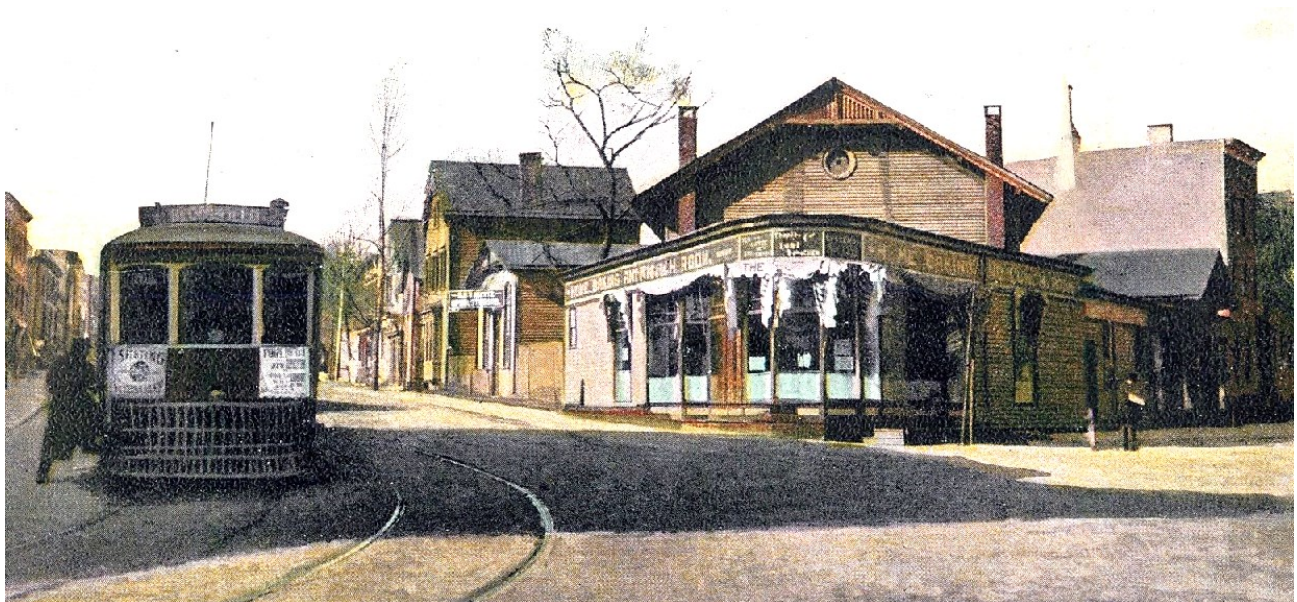

\$13 per month pay.

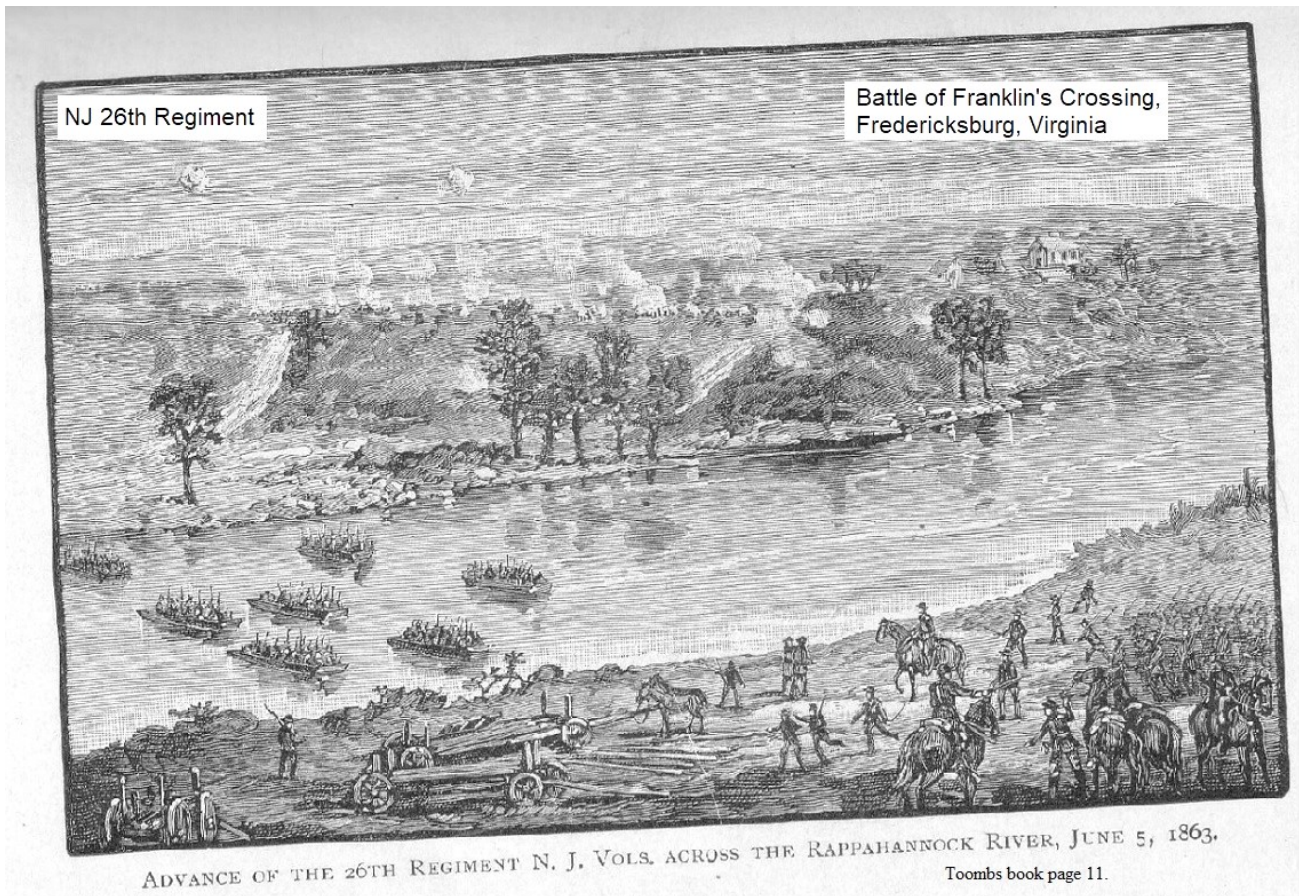


George Henry Pearce was age 17.5 when he patriotically enlisted 1862 in a 9-month NJ regiment. They were led by an incompetent officer.

Franklin's Crossing June 5-13. Reached Washington, D.C., June 17. Mustered out at Newark, N.J., June 27, 1863.

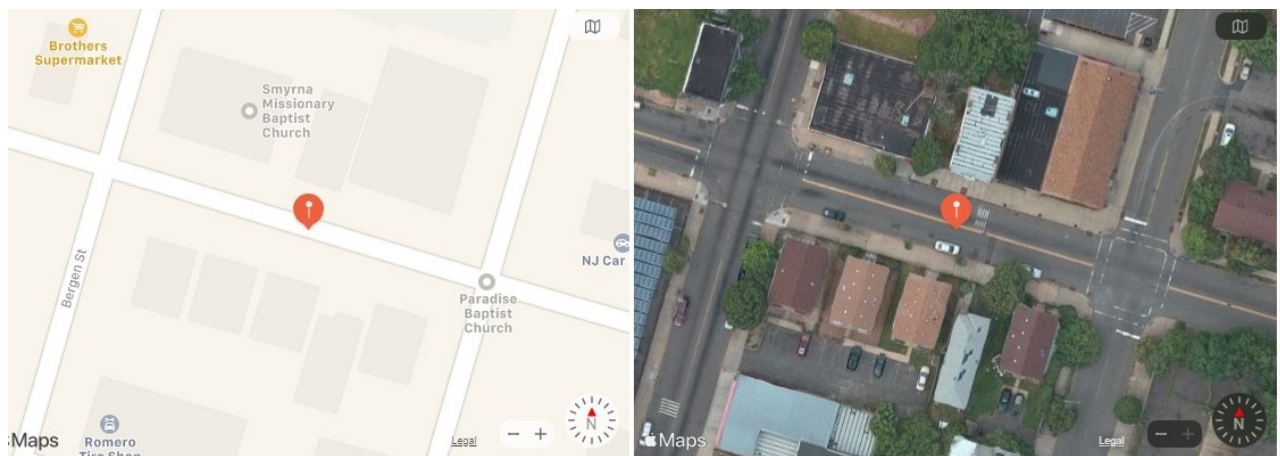
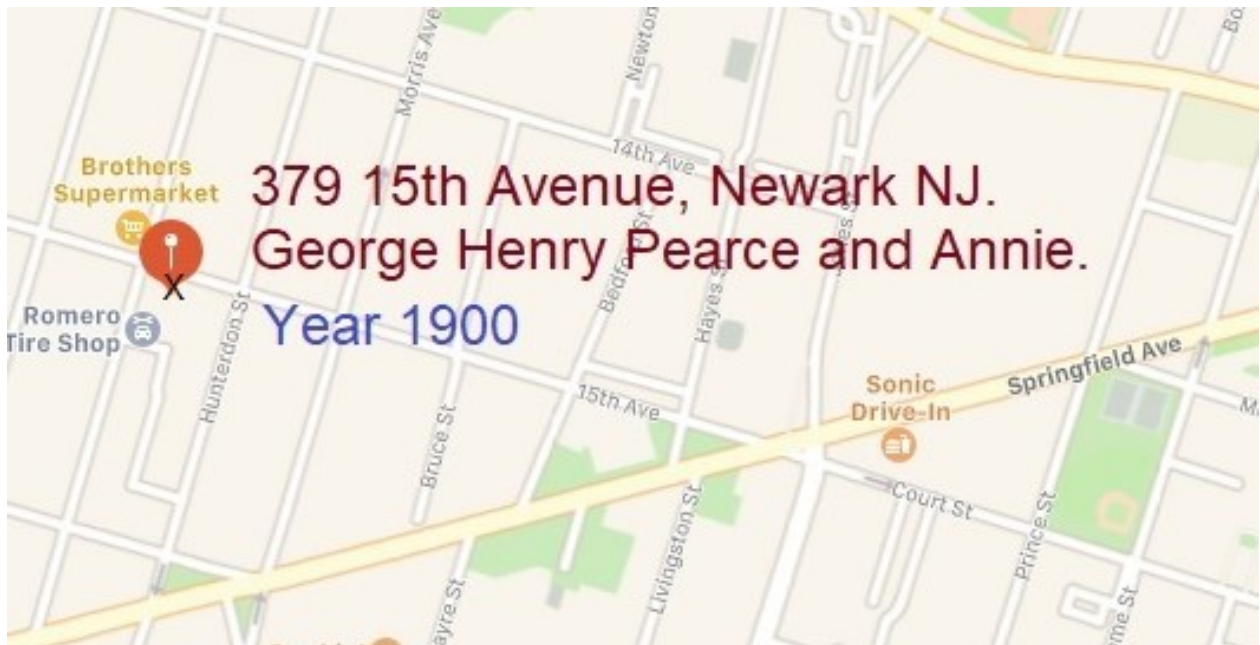




BROAD STREET—LOOKING SOUTH FROM MARKET STREET.

1920: 2nd child. **George Leslie PEARCE** 7/12/1876 NJ - 6/22/1920 Dayton Ohio (43). 1898-1915 Employed by Western Electric Company for 17 years in NJ and Chicago Illinois. Moved to Dayton Ohio in 1916.

George was a foreman in automatic screw machine department at Delco Company. Died in Dayton from chronic nephritis after being sick for 7 weeks. Big funeral from the Masonic Temple. Woodland Cemetery, Dayton, Ohio, Plot section 120, Lot 204.

His wife was Elizabeth L. 'Elsie' ? unknown maiden name.

1930: 5th child. **Oscar Henry PEARCE** 12/13/1881 Newark, NJ - 9/3/1930 (age 48) Did not marry. 1911 job as waiter in Newark, NJ area. 1911 lived as boarder at 498 18th Street, Newark, NJ. 1930 lived at 336 Waverly Ave, Newark, NJ, working as a Porter.

Oscar's 1918 WW1 registration card shows him age 37, tall with blue eyes and gray hair. He wrote the nearest relative as his oldest sister Mrs. Mabel Pearce Jensen. Their parents were deceased by 1912.

Mabel and Charles lived briefly at 113 Plane St, Newark NJ.



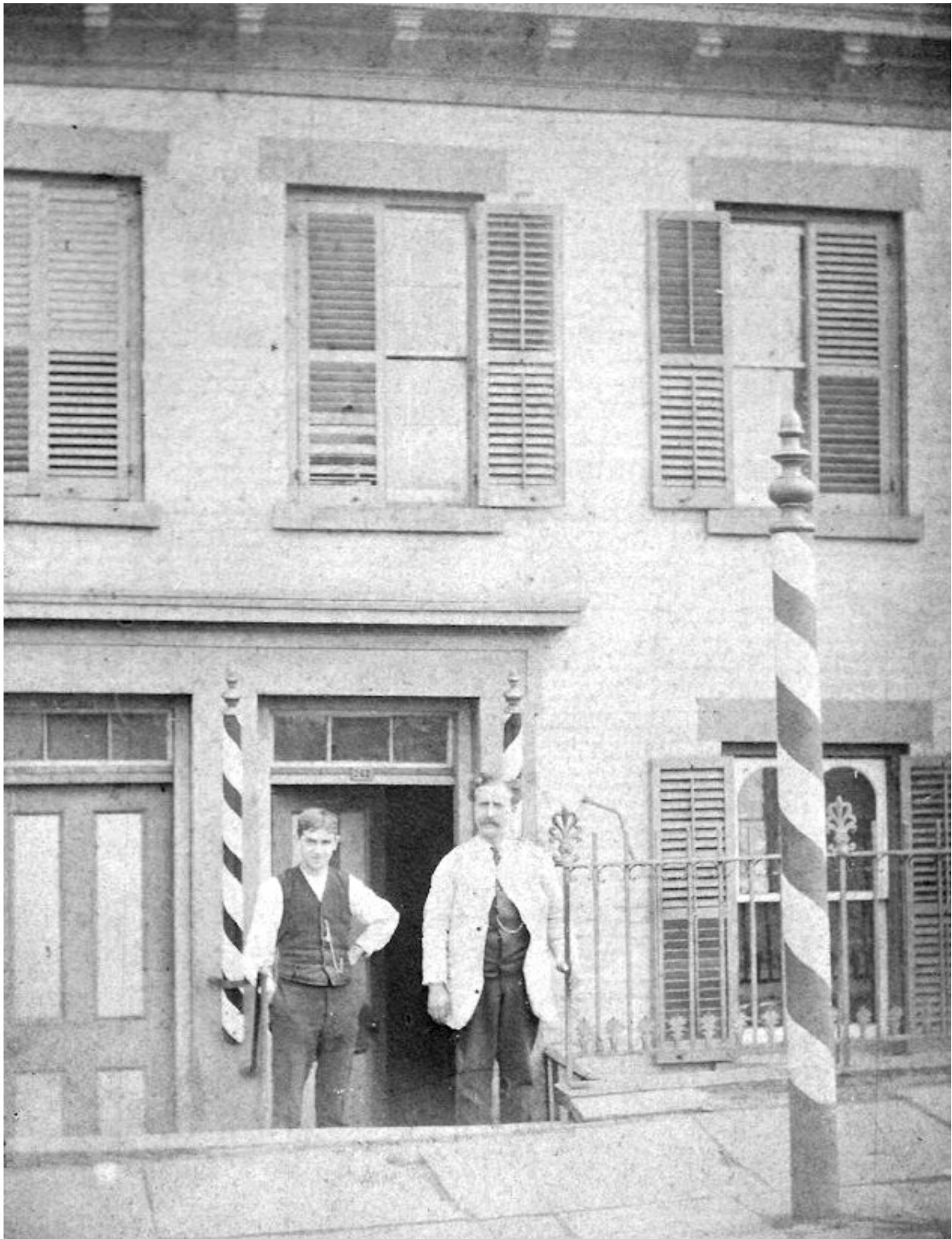


