Vic married **Jacqueline Jane "Jacky" Joyce** on 8/14/1946 at Cicero, Illinois.

Mrs. Jacky Pierce was born 7/26/1926 in Baraboo, Wisconsin.

Vic worked at Baraboo Ordnance Works. I believe that Vic was in the WW2 military.

They had 2 children born in Madison, Wisconsin : **David Victor 'Vic' PIERCE** 2/9/1948 and **Victoria Lee "Vicki" PIERCE** 8/28/1955.

Victor Pierce died 10/26/1983 (59) and Jacky died 11/15/1989 (63). Jacky rests at Saint Joseph's Cem, Baraboo, Wisconsin. Probably, Vic is buried there too.

Appears Vicki's name was switch to "Lee" afterwards.

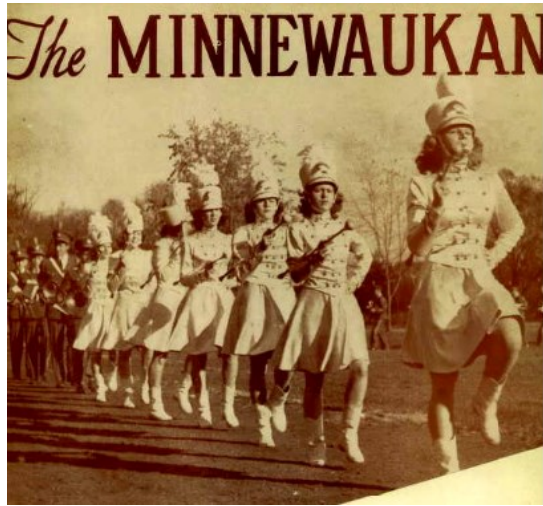
Jacky married Victor Edward PIERCE on 8/14/1946.
