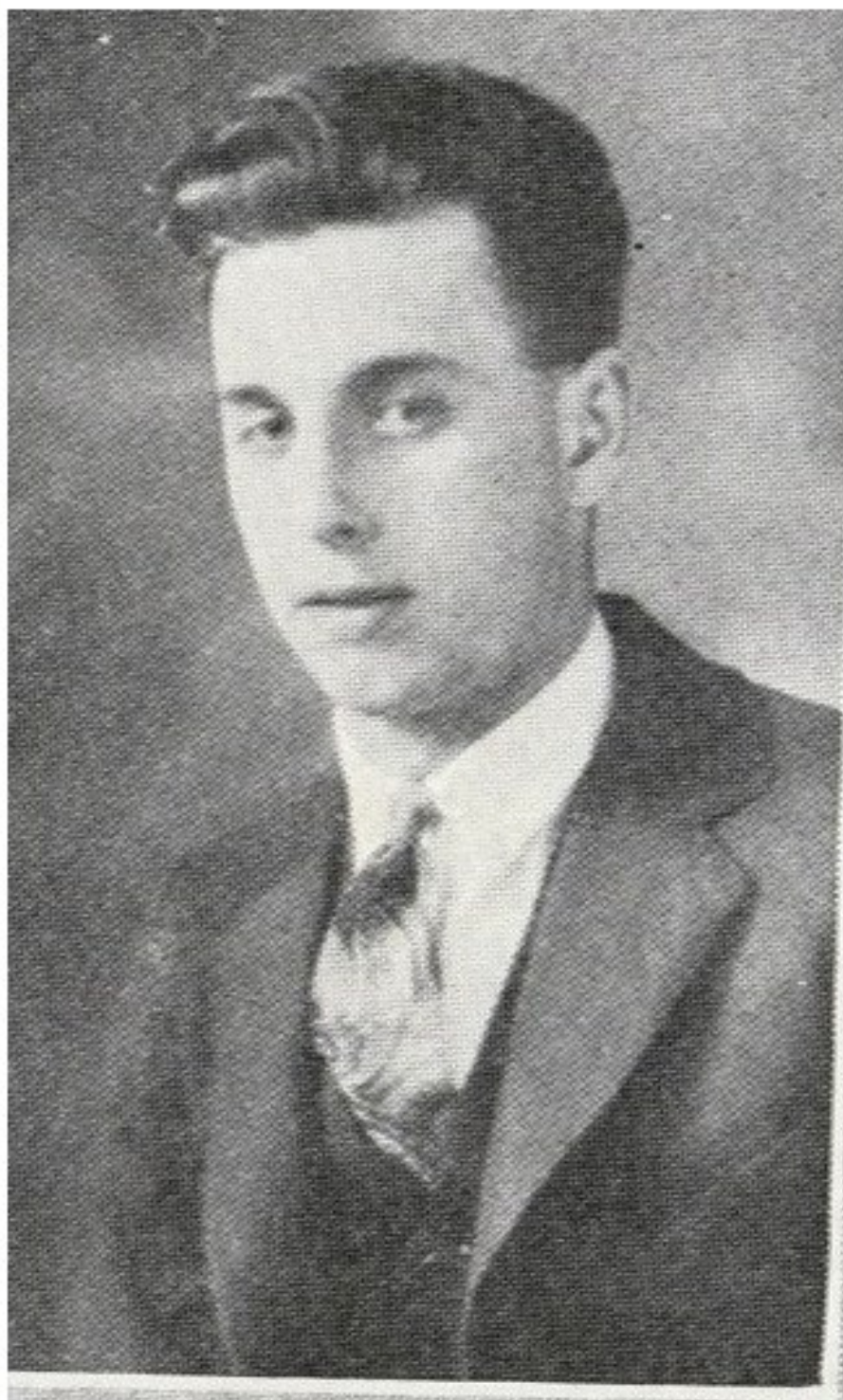
Pearce branch #2, generation #6.

Notice a woman at the front door. Probably Mabel Pierce !



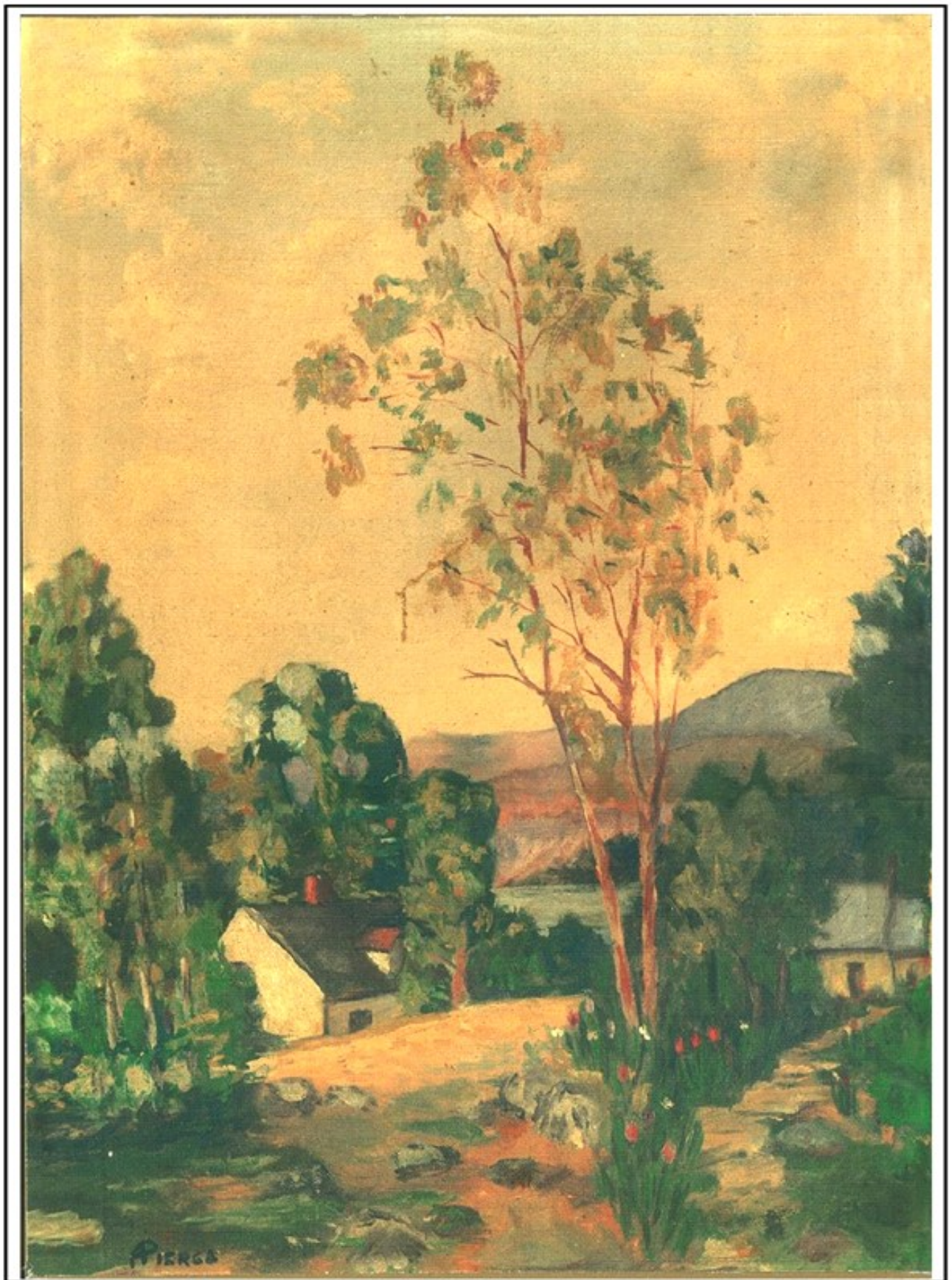

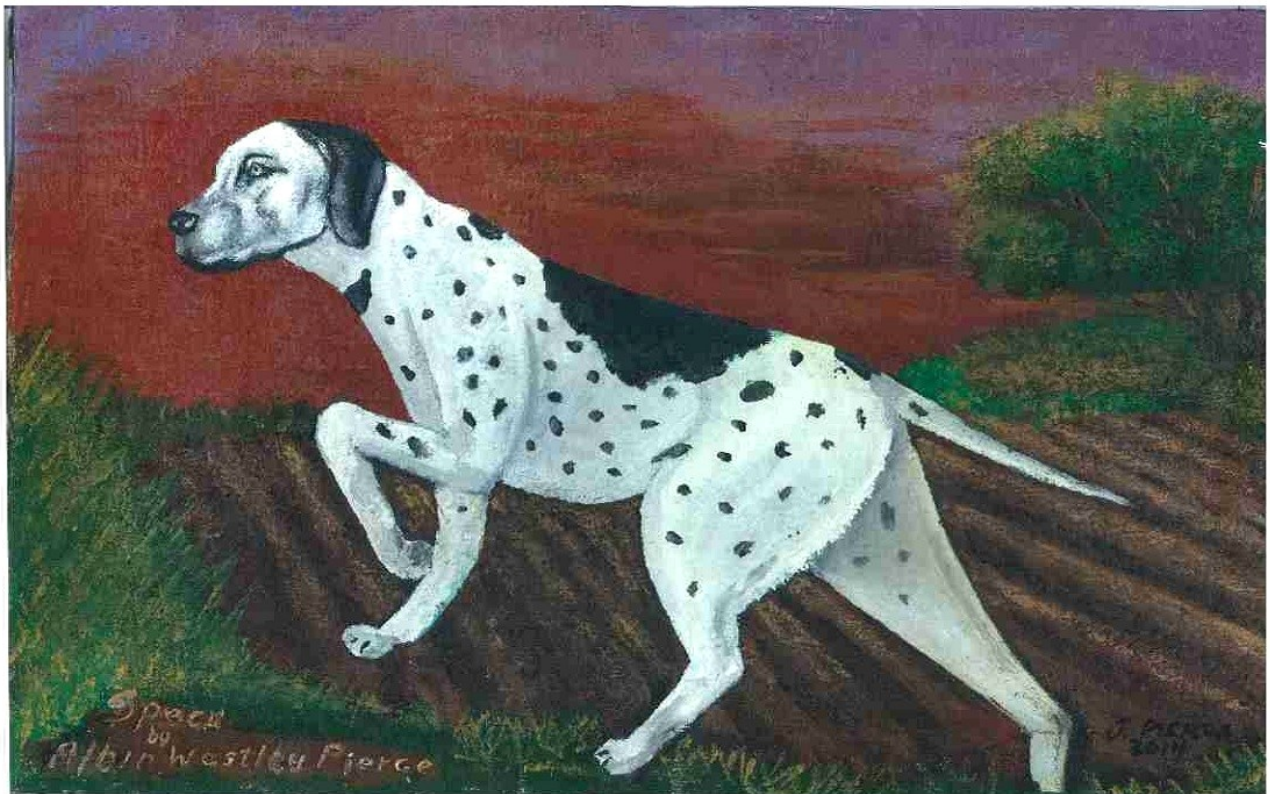

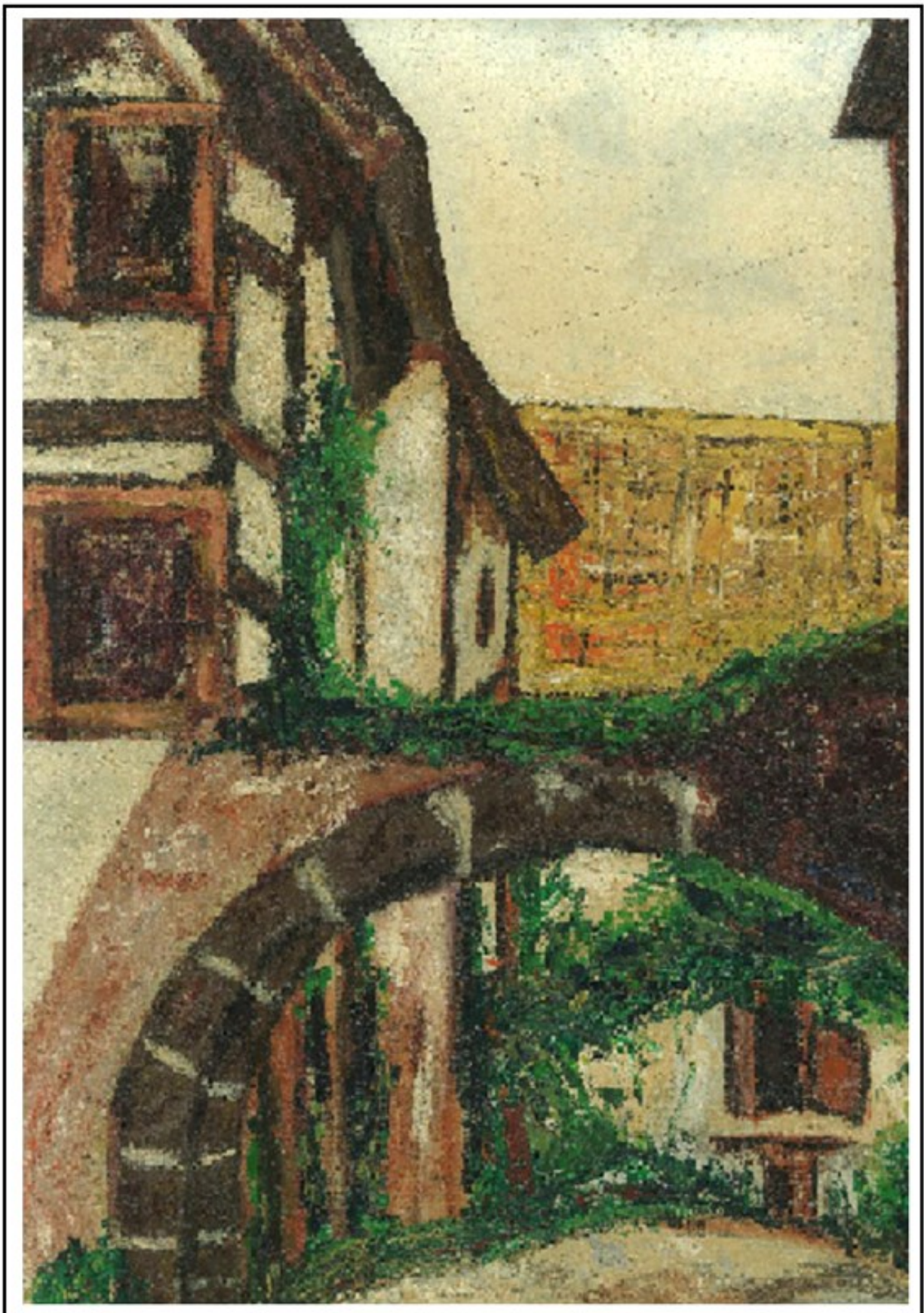
