CLARENCE PIERCE BURNED SEVERELY, DIES IN HOSPITAL

Severe burns suffered Monday night at his home on State Road 44 west of Lecanto caused the death of Clarence E. Pierce, 80, Tuesday at Citrus Memorial Hospital.

The fire started in a short-circuited radio beside Mr. Pierce's bed. Invalided by an injured hip, he was able to roll out of bed but not to safety before he was badly burned.

The flames were confined to his room. He was a native of New York State and had lived in Lecanto for 16 years. His wife, Mrs. Bessie Pierce, survives.

Funeral services were held this morning at the graveside in Lecanto with Rev. Don Walsh of the Crystal River Methodist Church officiating. Porter Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

He was a native of Pine Brook NJ. Not New York.
